## Upcoming maintenance from Melbourne Water Drainage Reserve at Canberra Street

Melbourne Water needs to undertake maintenance activities consisting of beach reinstatement and sand/rock replenishment in some areas of the Tidal Canals. These maintenance activities will be completed prior to the December school holidaying period from 17<sup>th</sup> October until 16<sup>th</sup> December 2011. Maintenance activities will recommence in February 2012 after school holidays.

### About the maintenance / operational works

Melbourne Water is responsible for the maintenance of the beaches walls, jetties and other features of the Tidal Canals.

From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October until 16<sup>th</sup> December 2011, we will be utilising our drainage reserve at the end of Canberra Street to temporarily store materials such as sand, rock and transport for the operational works. A description of the works is as follows:

Schooner Bay Drive. & Brigintine Court	Sand retrieval to beach areas. Level and spread sand to beach area	Barge Access	October 2011
Snapper Point Drive	Sand retrieval & placement of 50 tonne of new sand to beach	Barge Access	November 2011
Brigintine Court	Sand retrieval to beach areas allow to dry and then spread and level	Barge Access	November 2011
Myola Street	Placement of 20 tonne of rock spalls to protect the footings of the retaining wall	Barge Access	December 2011

Palm Beach Drive & Castaway Court	Sand retrieval & placement of 75 tonne of new sand to beach areas. Modify and enlarge rock groynes with 30 tonne of rock spalls to stop further slippages and undermining of spoon drain	Barge Access	December 2011

### How will works impact local residents?

Local residents may experience construction noise and a small increase in traffic during the works hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm Monday – Friday. The project team will do their best to minimise these impacts.

All plant and materials will be kept within the chainmesh fencing and double gates to ensure both the safety and security of materials and equipment on site, as well as the safety of residents. The shade cloths have been installed to provide reduced visibility within the drainage reserve.

The storage of plant and materials, and work conducted onsite, will meet current occupational health and safety requirements. Entry to the site will be restricted to Melbourne Water staff and prohibited to both residents and the public. The Melbourne Water barge and boat will not be moored onsite overnight.
