## Bore allocation increase – pump testing

Melbourne Water is arranging an increase in the amount of bore water allocated to Gladesville Boulevard. This will ensure there is sufficient water available for top up purposes and to fill the Quiet Lakes if required.

As part of Southern Rural Water's requirements for this increase, Melbourne Water needs to conduct a number of tests over the next 10 days, including a 'pump flow rate' and 'constant rate continuous pump' test. These tests measure the performance of the aquifer and will give Southern Rural Water an indication of how much the bore allocation can be increased.

It is likely that you will notice an increase in water level in the Quiet Lakes during the tests and the water level may take a few days to subside once pumping is complete.
