Saturday jetty replacement works

The Jetty Replacement Project is currently underway within the tidal waterways and is aiming to complete ten jetties before the Christmas break, and a further six jetties in January. In order to meet these timeframes it will be necessary to work on Saturdays from 19 November until the end of January 2012 (excluding the Christmas shutdown period from 24 December to 8 January).

Working together

We understand the importance of minimising disruption for those who use the river on Saturdays for boating or recreation. As such, we aim to reduce disturbance from our works as much as possible.

During Saturday works we will:

- Restrict work hours to 9am to 6pm, as required by Council
- Confine works and the working barge to one area at a time
- Not transport materials through the canals or utilise any easements
- Keep noise generating tasks to a minimum, and
- Endeavour not to hinder the boating thoroughfare.

In addition, crews will wear the appropriate hi-visibility clothing to ensure they are clearly visible.
