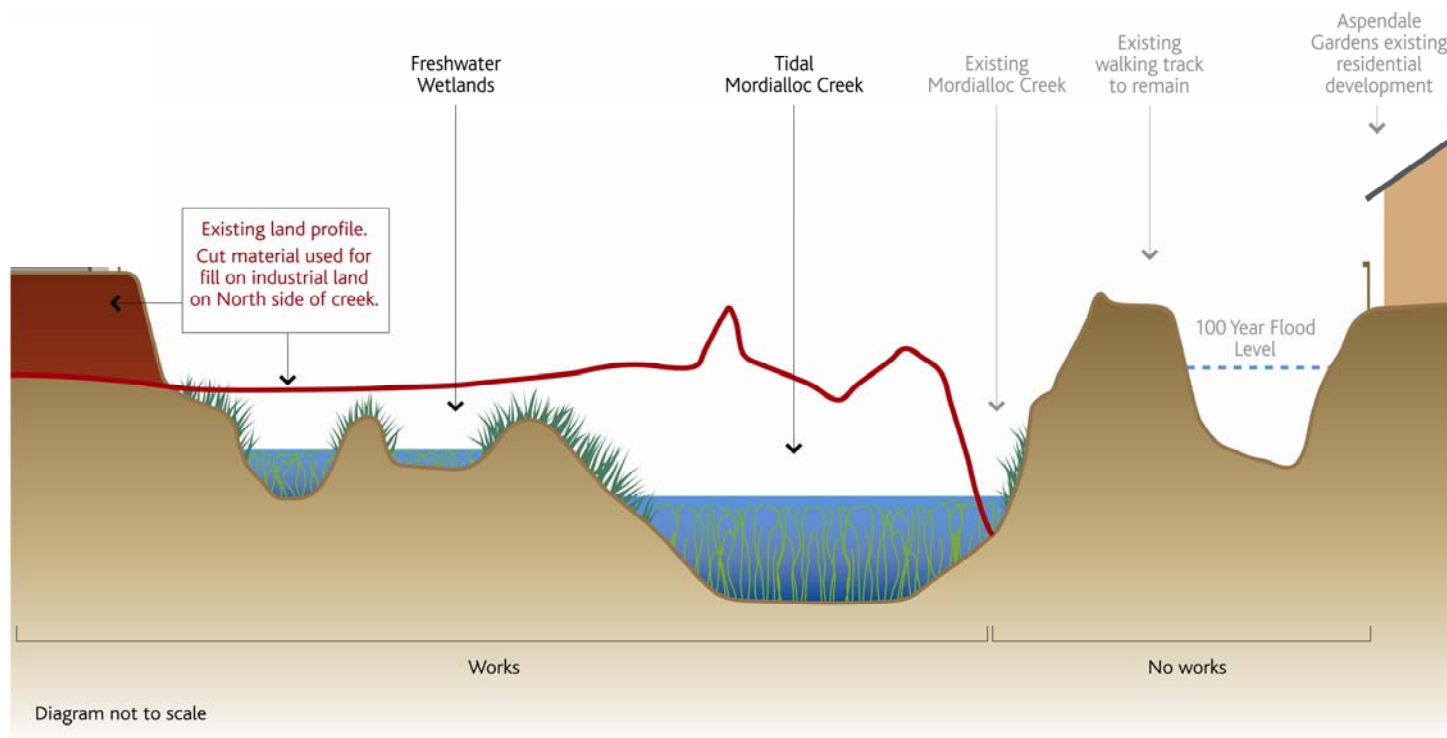


# Mordialloc Creek Wetlands construction in 2009



**In 2009, Melbourne Water, with support from Kingston City Council, will create a new Mordialloc Creek Wetland between Waterways and the Wells Rd bridge at Aspendale Gardens.**

#### What will we do?

- Make the creek wider
- Create a large new wetland
- Put in lots of new native plants.

#### How will we do the works?

- Remove the levee bank on the Braeside side of the creek
- Remove soil and silt from the floodplain and place this on land on the Braeside side of the creek
- Plant native plants in and around the wetland.

#### How will the works help Mordialloc Creek?

Following the works the creek will:

- manage flooding better
- have cleaner water
- look more attractive
- provide a place for native birds, animals and fish to live.

#### What about the path?

The path may be fenced off from the work area when necessary for safety reasons.

#### What will the impacts of the works be?

As with any earthworks, there may be dust and noise depending on wind conditions and direction. The construction company will be required to control this as much as possible.

Trucks and other equipment will enter the works site from Braeside.
