Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Shaft construction at Fennell Reserve

John Holland would like to advise that site establishment works at Fennell Reserve are progressing well.

Works will soon commence to construct the main vertical access shaft for the Melbourne Main Sewer Replacement. The 15 metre deep by 12 metres in diameter shaft will provide underground access, enabling future tunnelling operations to take place.

Shaft support works will be undertaken prior to excavation, and will involve the installation of piles to a maximum depth of approximately 19.5 metres. Piles will be drilled into the ground, concreted and reinforced with steel.

Piling works are due to commence on Monday, 15 September 2008 and will take approximately five weeks to complete. Works will be undertaken during the standard hours of Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm with no truck movements taking place after 1pm on Saturday.

All efforts will be made to minimise noise during the shaft piling, however given the nature of the works, some noise will be experienced. Truck movements for deliveries and removal of spoil (excavated ground material), will use the approved route of Normanby Road for access rather than local streets.
