

Melbourne Main Sewer Replacement

Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Site Establishment at Flinders Wharf

Work has begun on the \$220 million Melbourne Main Sewer Replacement, a planned and essential infrastructure project which will deliver health and environmental benefits to meet the future growth of Melbourne.

The project is being constructed by John Holland on behalf of Melbourne Water and is due for completion in early 2012.

John Holland will be establishing six shaft sites along the sewer route to facilitate construction. A shaft site will be established at both Flinders and South Wharfs to facilitate the Yarra River crossing works. Each site will accommodate a vertical access shaft for tunnelling and work area for the river crossing works. Construction of the Flinders Wharf site will begin late October 2008.

The Flinders Wharf site is located to the west of the historical Shed 5 building south of Wurundjeri Way.

Work to establish the site is expected to take approximately four weeks. Work will take place during the standard construction hours, Monday to Saturday, 7am to 6pm, however no truck movements will take place after 1pm on Saturday. Initial site establishment work will include –

- Utility connections;
- Installation of temporary fencing;
- Erection of 2.4m hoardings (fences) around the site perimeter;
- Placement and assembly of prefabricated buildings and signage;
- Site preparation including investigations to confirm the conditions and locations of existing foundations.

All efforts will be made to minimise noise during the site establishment works, however some noise will be expected. The project will comply with all relevant EPA Guidelines including those regarding noise.

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Construction work at the Flinders Wharf shaft site is expected to be complete in September 2011.
