Toorourrong Reservoir Upgrade

Heritage Victoria grants permit for Toorourrong Reservoir dam upgrade works

On Monday the 13th of December, 2010, Heritage Victoria notified Melbourne Water that they had granted a permit for essential dam safety upgrade works.

What does this decision mean for the project?

Effective immediately, works will commence on various aspects of the project including the dismantling of the spillway in preparation for building the new structure.

Heritage Interpretation

Heritage is really important to us, but at the same time we need to balance the need to update our infrastructure to meet modern day safety standards. What we aim for in projects like this is striking a balance with meeting these standards while respecting the past.

Heritage Victoria has indicated, in explicit terms, what is required of Melbourne Water in relation to the heritage interpretation on this site.

Melbourne Water will comply with the instructions as outlined in the permit.
