3.1) OUTLET CONNECTIONS TO WATERCOURSES

Generally, stormwater connections to watercourses are constructed as per the attached standard drawing. However, this may vary based on site variations.

Outlet connections are to be designed/constructed according to Melbourne Water specifications. Further details on the method of connection will be provided upon assessment of the proposal by Melbourne Water.

3.2) INLET CONNECTIONS TO MELBOURNE WATER DRAINS

Any works to be carried out on Melbourne Water's "live" drainage assets must be carried out by a Registered Contractor, subject to Melbourne Water's registration requirements.

Inlet connections are to be designed/constructed according to Melbourne Water specifications. Further details on the method of connection will be provided upon assessment of the proposal by Melbourne Water.

4) PRELIMINARY PLANS TO BE SUBMITTED TO MELBOURNE WATER

Melbourne Water requires plans showing the following details to be submitted with this application form: (Additional information may be necessary.)

- The size and alignment of the proposed connection, including Melbourne Water's asset.
- The size and alignment of any existing connection to Melbourne Water's asset.
- The proposed connection angled at 45° downstream to the flow in Melbourne Water's asset.
- For open waterways, pipe outlet velocity not greater than 1.5m/s. Long section indicating grades etc to be submitted to Melbourne Water.
- Any standard drawing accompanying this application form.
- Details plans of the development including any driveways, landscaping etc.
- Detailed cross section of the creek and the proposed drain indicating creek invert levels, width, depth top bank, surrounding topography etc shall be required to be submitted. Photographs of the area affected would be useful.

Please note: separate approval may need to be attained from other Authorities, Private Owners that may be affected by the necessary works

Once all details are finalised, all documentation is to be submitted to Melbourne Water for approval
