# Holden Reservoir Inlet Pipeline Project

## Project update – changed traffic conditions, Melton Highway at Sanctuary Road roundabout

### **About the project**

The new Holden Reservoir Inlet Pipeline will be approximately three kilometres long and will travel along the media strip of Melton Highway, westbound from Antionetta Way, Hillside across the north side at Sanctuary Road. This project is the first phase of a three-part overarching project which will supply high-quality drinking water to Melbourne's growing outer west.

#### What are we currently doing?

The works have progressed on the northern side of Melton Highway and will now enter the Sanctuary Road roundabout roadway.

We have revised the traffic impacts since our last correspondence to you. *Please see the map below for further details.* 



For the safety of motorists and workers the roundabout at Sanctuary Road has been modified. There will be no right turn from Sanctuary Road onto the Melton Highway and The Regency, Hillside will be closed to traffic exiting and entering the roundabout.

Motorists will need to seek alternative routes at other locations to enter the Melton Highway. Please see the detour map over page for further details.





#### When will this be happening?

Works impacting the Sanctuary Road roundabout will start on Tuesday 26 November and will take approximately eight weeks until late January 2020.

#### **Impacts to public transport**

Five bus stops along the 476 route will temporarily close as works are carried out at the roundabout. All bus stops on The Regency, Sanctuary Road and Beattys Road will be closed.

Passengers will need to catch the bus from Wattle Valley Drive, Hillside.

Passengers walking from Sanctuary Road and Beattys Road can safely cross the Melton Highway at a newly installed pedestrian crossing adjacent to the Sanctuary Road roundabout.

The five bus stops will be closed from Tuesday 26 November until late January 2020.
