Stony Creek Rehabilitation Works - Revegetation

16th April 2020

Melbourne water is committed to enhancing life and liveability in your area. We will soon be planting riparian revegetation along Stony Creek in Cruickshank Park, Yarraville, and along the banks in West Footscray.

This project delivers actions from the Melbourne Water Stony Creek Rehabilitation Plan. These works will contribute to creating a continuous corridor of vegetation along Stony Creek, providing habitat for wildlife, and improving amenity for the community.

Planned works include:

- Preparing planting plots to make suitable for planting
- Installing jute roll to protect the plants and banks
- Planting over 3500 indigenous grasses, bushes and trees in the riparian zone
- Ongoing maintenance for 2 years to ensure plants establish successfully

Weed control spraying of the planting plots is planned for the end of April, with a follow up spray run in May. Each run will take 1-2 days.

Planting works will commence in June. You can expect to see work vehicles accessing the park to bring plants and materials to site. Planting works are expected to take 2-3 weeks.

Works will occur between 7am-4pm on weekdays only.
