

Hawthorn Sewer Upgrade

Works Notification – Change to night works

The next stage of the relining works on Murphy St is for grout to be inserted between the old and new pipe from manholes 1 and 3. The grouting pump will be set up initially at manhole 1 and later moved to manhole 2.

Due to high sewer flows, grouting works have been rescheduled between **Sunday and Thursday 9pm until 7am**. These works have been delayed and are now scheduled to start **Wednesday 10 June 2020** and will take approximately two weeks to complete.

What are we doing?

Grout will be pumped into the void between the existing sewer line and new pipe. This involves setting up a specialised pumping system to inject the grout 15 metres underground and 290 metres along the new sewer pipe.



What to expect?

- Temporary traffic disruption at manhole 2 at the intersection of Murphy and River streets, Richmond. Traffic flows will be maintained, with lane closures and detours set up when works are in progress
- Traffic controllers will be present to assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians
- Noise will be generated from the grouting pumps and generators. This noise can be compared to a lawn mower
- During the day, a small site will remain in place on Murphy Street near manhole 2 (once grouting shifts here), with the road remaining open to traffic

There will be no disruptions to your water or sewer services during these works.


Working hours


Grouting works will be scheduled between Sunday and Thursday 9pm until 7am.

Location of works

Grouting works will commence at manhole one at the intersection of Murphy and Vaughan Streets and then move to manhole 2 at the intersection of Murphy and Rivers Streets.
