

Hawthorn Sewer Upgrade

Site Compound Update – Extension to occupancy

Relining works are continuing on Denham Street, Hawthorn and Murphy Street, Richmond. Works will be scheduled both during the day and overnight, as some works can only be safely completed when sewer flows are low.

For day works, the site compound will be used by our staff 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday. For night works, the site compound will be accessed Sunday to Thursday during shift changeover. Changeovers occur at 7am, 7pm and 9pm and staff will be present at the site compound for up to an hour either side of these times.

Sewer relining works are now scheduled to be completed by October 2020.

What to Expect

- Our staff will be working 10 to 12 hour shifts, with changeover occurring at 7am, 7pm and 9pm. Staff will be present at the site at these times.
- Deliveries to the site compound are scheduled during the day only. You will be notified if there is cause for these times to change.
- Access to the compound overnight will be minimised by storing equipment at the manhole work sites.
- Vehicles and trucks will be returned and stored at the compound at the end of each night shift.

Our team are committed to minimising noise impacts from our site compound during the night.

The following measures have been put in place for night works:

- Reversing beepers on vehicles are turned off.
- Access to the site compound during night shift operations will be minimised.
- Light sources will be turned away from properties, where possible.
- The entrance gate has been altered to reduce noise.
- Conversations will occur within site compound buildings and not outside in the open.

Please note there will be an all staff toolbox on site between 7am and 9am on Wednesday 17 June 2020. You may notice increased movement on site.

We understand these required works can be disruptive and appreciate your patience.

Please note that our sewer works may be delayed due to weather, fluctuating sewer flows and potential coronavirus restrictions.
