

# Hawthorn Sewer Upgrade

## Works notification – Further manhole works

As part of the Hawthorn Sewer Upgrade, manhole 5, located at the intersection of Denham and Church Streets, Hawthorn, needs to be decommissioned. Preparation works will continue on **Thursday 25 June 2020** and will take approximately 2 days to complete.

### What are we doing?

As part of the preparation work, we will be setting up rigging inside the manhole to assist with the decommissioning works. This involves using cutting tools and high pressure machinery therefore a temporary work site will be set up around manhole 5.

### What to expect?



- Temporary work site set up and removed each day
- Temporary traffic disruption around manhole 5 while works are occurring
- Road closed to traffic turning into Church Street from Denham Street
- Road closed to traffic turning onto Denham Street (westbound) from Church Street
- Access to all driveways will be maintained
- Traffic controllers will be onsite to assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians around the temporary works
- Some odour will be present when opening and accessing the manhole
- There will be no disruptions to your water or sewer services during these works

## Working hours

These works will be scheduled between 9.30am and 3.30pm Monday to Thursday

## Location of works

Work will take place at sewer manhole 5 in the road reserve at the intersection of Denham and Church Streets



## Be prepared

We understand these required works can be disruptive and appreciate your patience. Please note that our sewer works may be delayed due to weather, fluctuating sewer flows and potential coronavirus restrictions.
