Holden Reservoir Inlet Pipeline Project

Lane closures on Melton Highway

About the project

To improve life and liveability Melbourne Water is committed to providing Melbourne with world-class water infrastructure. To deliver on this commitment, we have completed the construction of the 4.15km Holden Reservoir Pipeline, to supply residents and businesses in Melbourne's developing outer-west region with a reliable and safe water supply.

What are we doing?

We will be reducing traffic across Melton Highway near Calder Park Drive (see map) to connect the new pipeline to the existing water main that intersects at the Melton Highway Service Road near the Calder Park Drive intersection.

This construction zone will reduce the Melton Highway by one lane (from three lanes to two lanes) and will require traffic to merge to pass. The Melton Highway Service Road along with pedestrian access to the bus stop will remain open.

Due to these works, we will also be active in the centre median strip further along the Melton Highway towards Sanctuary Road, there will be no traffic impacts at these additional locations.

When will this be happening?

- From Monday 10 May 2021 - Melton Highway works are scheduled to commence and are expected to take one week to complete.
- Monday 10 to Wednesday 12 May 2021 – day works (7am to 5pm) around Melton Highway as we set up the site.
- From Wednesday 12 May 2021 - commissioning works will run for 24 hours per day (including night works).
- From 14 May 2021 until complete – day works (7am to 5pm) for site pack down and reinstatement.

What to expect

- Traffic management on the Melton Highway to ensure safety and ease of traffic flow
- Motorists travelling westbound will merge from three lanes to two in order to pass the construction zone
- Noise from road cutting and shaft digging equipment
- Works will be conducted at night when installing the pipeline connection
- Footpaths and pedestrian access will remain open with short detours around construction zone
- Bus services and bus stops in this area will not be impacted by these works
- Access to and from the Melton Highway Service Road will remain open
