## Why this project is important

Melbourne Water has upgraded and completed dam remediation works of the Upper Yarra Dam. These works ensure the ongoing integrity and stability of the dam wall, continuing to supply world class drinking water for Melbournians.

Melbourne Water and our project delivery partner, Seymour Whyte, thank the local community for their patience and understanding while we undertook these works.



## Project works completed

After commencing works on site to upgrade the Upper Yarra Dam in October 2019, we have staged our works to maintain the integrity and stability of the dam wall. With the civil earthworks now completed, we move our focus to finalise the ancillary works.

Seymour Whyte has made improvements to the campground amenities and successfully excavated and laid material to create 542 metres of filter trench along the dam wall.







### STAGED WORKS COMPLETED

During construction we have moved a lot of earthfill, rockfill and clay. We have utilised materials from the existing dam and immediate area as well as importing the additional materials needed.


These include;

Excavation of approximately 265,000 m<sup>3</sup> of dam wall material

128,481

3,974 truck and trailers


181,518m<sup>3</sup> of placed material to reinstate the dam wall

The project has employed over 20 local residents from the Yarra Ranges Council area in a variety roles.



Narrap Rangers, Wurundjeri Woi-Wurrung Council's Natural Resource Management Team, were engaged to undertake the maintenance work on Country which involved grass cutting and weed spraying and general maintenance.



As part of the site visit with Wesburn Primary School, students participated in a workshop facilitated by Seymour Whyte. Students were tasked with creating 'mini-dams' using the clay, sand and rocks being used as part of the construction works.

## Our fundraising efforts

Over the course of the project our contractors and personnel have been very generous and supported various local charities, purposely selected to address needs of the community during some particularly difficult times. Our fundraising efforts have included:

- Victorian Bushfire Appeal supporting local communities affected by the devastating fires
- LinC Upper Yarra assists people in need in the Upper Yarra Valley
- Foodbank provides more than 70% of the food rescued for food relief organisations
- Berry Street Christmas gift appeal for children in need
- SES Upper Yarra support for services and contribute to replacement of stolen equipment

Majority of the project has been constructed during COVID-19 restrictions and unfortunately some of the community site visits we had planned had to be cancelled or postponed. Despite this, we have still been able to host some visitors including Warburton Advancement League and classes from Wesburn Primary School.



#### WHAT IS LEFT TO DO



Installation of Mechanical and Electrical equipment within the new Seepage Weir and on the Dam crest

Construction of a new Aerator building on the crest

Reinstatement of the crest viewing area including the monument

Installation of new information boards throughout the shire

Reconnection of the High Voltage feed to the Dam

Revegetation works across the site and maintenance within the works area

Amenities improvements within the campground including upgrades to the main toilet block
