Kilsyth to Croydon South water mains renewal


Enhancing life and liveability in your area

To ensure Melbourne Water can continue to supply a safe and reliable water supply, we are replacing the water mains on the 4.5 kilometre pipe track between Dunrossil Drive (Kilsyth) and Yarraduct Place (Croydon South).

The M54, M55, and M56 water mains are between 80 and 100 years old and reaching the end of their service life, so Melbourne Water is replacing them with two new 1350mm pipelines in 2023 and 2024.

How this affects you

To ensure your safety while work is being completed, we will close the pipe track from February 2023 to late in 2024. The main detour for cyclists between Hawthory Road and Norton Road is shown below.



While it is disappointing to lose recreational access to the pipe track during construction, we hope you appreciate the need to provide water safely and securely for decades to come.

Reinstatement

After the water mains are replaced, Melbourne Water will reinstate any paths on the pipe track and revegetate the area, which will include the planting of at least two trees for each one removed.





Ongoing information

Melbourne Water will continue to keep you informed through notification letters or door knocks during appropriate stages of the project, and also welcomes queries by phone or email at any time.
