

North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation

Sewer works commencing 30 September 2024

Works to complete installation of the new liner in the North Yarra Main Sewer are scheduled to start from **Monday 30 September 2024**.

What we are doing

We will work our way from maintenance hole to maintenance hole starting from Burgundy Street/Rosanna Road intersection to The Boulevard/Mossman Drive intersection (*refer to map on the next page*). These works are anticipated to take approximately two weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Working Hours

- Works on Burgundy Street and Jika Street: **Night works Monday to Friday, between 7pm and 6am.**
- Works on The Boulevard: **Day works Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm.**

As we progress, we will keep you informed of these upcoming works. Dates and times are subject to change due to weather conditions and fluctuating sewer flows.

What to expect

- **Traffic management** will be present to assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians around our temporary work sites. Short detours will be required where maintenance holes are in the roadway. Please allow extra time when travelling through the area.
- **Noise** will be generated from the construction equipment. This noise can be compared to a lawn mower. We will implement noise reducing methods, where possible, to minimise disruption to the community.
- **Bright lights** will be used during night works. Where possible, lights will be directed away from neighbouring properties.
- **Odour** will be present when opening and accessing the maintenance hole. While smelly, it's harmless and will disappear when we finish.
- **Flow management** will be set up at nearby maintenance holes to assist with works. This may include the use of a sucker truck to reduce sewage flows.

There will be no interruption to your water or sewerage services during our works. If you experience any issues with your sewerage service, please contact Yarra Valley Water on 1300 304 688.
