# Mount Waverley water main renewal project

## Night works - asphaltting works on High Street Road

As part of the final works on the Mount Waverley water main renewal project, we will be completing reinstatement activities on High Street Road, Fleet Street and St Albans Street. These works will start on **Sunday 2 February 2025**.

### What are we doing

To safely complete works there will be a **full road closure** on sections of High Street Road, between Fleet Street and Hunter Street (refer to map). Works will be at night between **9pm and 5am** when traffic movement is at its lowest and will take approximately **two weeks** to complete.

**When:** Sunday 2 February to Thursday 13 February 2025 (weather permitting)

**Time:** 9pm – 5am (Sunday to Thursday)

### What to expect (nighttime only)

**Change in traffic:** There will be temporary changes to traffic conditions including road closures on sections of High Street Road where we will be working. We will work with residents and local businesses to reduce any impacts associated with these temporary changes.

**Detours:** There will be detours in place. Please follow traffic signage, take care around the works areas and allow extra time for travel.

**Lights:** Temporary light towers may be required during this time. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties.

**Noise and vibration:** There will be some noise from equipment used to complete asphaltting and line marking works. Where possible, sound dampening methods will be applied.

**Driveway access:** Residents will still be able to access their properties with the assistance of on-site traffic controllers, although there may be occasional delays depending on the location of equipment and specific works in progress.



Melbourne Water is owned by the Victorian Government. We manage Melbourne's water supply catchments, remove and treat most of Melbourne's sewage, and manage rivers and creeks and major drainage systems throughout the Port Phillip and Westernport region.



**Pedestrian access:** Footpaths along High Street Road will remain open. Pedestrians at the intersection crossings will be detoured to the next intersection to safely cross the road. Please travel safely around the work area.




Figure 1: Work area – High Street Road between Fleet Street and Hunter Street, Fleet Street and St Albans Street
