Mordialloc Main Sewer Rehabilitation

Night works from Sunday 16 February

Melbourne Water is committed to maintaining our world-class sewerage system in your local area. To prepare for rehabilitation works on the Mordialloc Main Sewer, we will start working on the maintenance holes.

What we are doing

We are removing structures from inside the maintenance holes to prepare for sewer relining in the coming months.

We will move from maintenance hole to maintenance hole as works progress.

This work is done at night when traffic and sewer flows are at their lowest.

When to expect us

Structures to be removed inside the maintenance hole



Works will commence from Sunday 16 February and will take up to three weeks to complete, weather permitting. We will be working between 7pm and 5am.

These dates and times are subject to change with little or no prior notice due to changing weather and sewer flows.

What to expect

- Traffic management will be present to assist motorists, bike riders and pedestrians around our temporary work sites.
- Noise will be generated from the cutting tools being used inside the maintenance holes and equipment from above.
- There will be some odour when opening and accessing the maintenance holes. We recommend closing your doors and windows while we are working close to your property.
- To maintain safety, our crew may communicate in loud voices to others located down the maintenance hole.
- Bright lights will be used during night works. Where possible, lights will be directed away from neighbouring property windows.
