# **Waverley Road Retarding Basin between Lawrence Rd and Scotchmans Creek Trail**

#### 12 June 2025

### **Project background**

Melbourne Water maintain assets to ensure that are safe for the community to use and continue to be part of what makes living here so great.

The pedestrian bridge at the Waverley Road Retarding Basin is an important link, providing community access to and from the Scotchmans Creek Trail. That's why, Melbourne Water is repairing the bridge to maintain its safe condition for now and generations to come.

#### What we are doing

Works will involve replacing the decking boards and railings that are showing signs of wear and tear.

#### When are the works happening?

Work is scheduled between **Tuesday 8 July and Friday 11 July 2025**. **Work hours are between 7:30am and 4:30pm**.

Works may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or access issues.

### What this means for you

# The bridge will be temporarily closed to all pedestrian and cycle traffic while we get to work.

It will reopen at the end of each working day and close again at the beginning of the next. Detours will be in place to direct traffic around the works. See maps below for suggested routes.

## Suggested Detour

Please see map and information below for suggested detour while works are underway. To cross the creek while the bridge is closed there is a 15 minute walk through the surround streets

Walk 1.1 km, 15 minutes

From Lawrence Road, Mount Waverley

- Head west on Oxford Street toward Peru Court (341 meters)
- Turn left onto Regent Street (268 meters)
- Turn left onto Waverley Road (349 meters) ٠
- Turn left onto Scammell Close (190 meters) •

Arrive at Waverley Road Basin, Scotchmans Creek Trail, Mount Waverley
