Mount Evelyn Water Treatment Plant

To continue our vital work in safeguarding Melbourne's water supply, Melbourne Water has started works to construct a new back-up water treatment plant in Mount Evelyn. The new treatment plant, built within the Tramway Track Pipe Reserve, will prepare us for the future and provide greater water security for today, tomorrow and generations to come.

Asphalting works - from Wednesday 30 July 2025

What are we doing:

From the end of July, our project team will start asphalting works on the new access road connecting Tramway Road and the new building site. The works will involve grading/profiling of the roadway to create an even, level surface, pouring asphalt in layers onto the prepared roadway, and rolling and compacting the ashpalt to achieve a smooth, durable finish. These works are expected to take approximately one week to complete.

What to expect:

During the asphalting works, neigbours can expect construction noise during grading and profiling of the roadway. Residents close to the building site may also experience some dust and minor vibration from these activities.

When:

Asphalting will occur from Wednesday, 30 July 2025 for approximately one week. Please note that dates are subject to change with inclement weather.

Time:

7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday while these works are underway.
