

Reimagining Eumemmerring Creek

Reimagining Your Creek projects aim to create desirable open spaces where people can interact with nature. One of the existing creeks to be naturalised is Eumemmerring Creek that runs through Doveton and Eumemmerring.

What's involved

We're transforming almost two kilometres of the existing Eumemmerring Creek, from Doveton Avenue, Doveton through to Lace Street, Eumemmerring. This area is currently an underground drain with concrete sections and grass channels. See back page for proposed upgrades map.

Melbourne Water is leading the design and delivery of the project in partnership with the City of Casey, Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) and with support from Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action (DEECA) and Bunurong Land Council Aboriginal Corporation.

Enhance biodiversity and habitat for birds, frogs, insects and other local wildlife.



Revitalise 2.4 hectares of open space, increasing shade and cooling to create a more resilient environment.





Transform approximately 2km of underground drain and concrete sections to create a more natural waterway.



Expand public open space and provide new recreational opportunities for the local community.

We will work together to design and construct a reimagined open space that meets community expectations and achieves our requirement for a safe and healthy waterway.



Potential ideas and options to consider

Together we can improve the health of the waterway and make the creek a place that looks, sounds and feels like a waterway. The proposed redesign of this section of Eumemmerring Creek could include ideas and suggestions that:

Create natural landmarks and amenities that invite the local community to engage with the landscape.





Allow people to cross, interact and engage with, the waterway and wet habitat areas.
