Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Stage 1

Stage 1 of the Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project is due to start in the week commencing **24 May 2017**. Works for this stage will involve digging up the top of the manhole to ensure safe access into the sewer for stage 2 sewer relining works.

These works will take approximately **5-7 days** to complete for each manhole and will be performed during the day between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and occasionally on Saturday's between 7am to 1:30pm.


Please be advised that council rubbish collection will still occur as per usual.

What to expect?

- Some odour when the manhole is first opened.
- Some noise from the movement of trucks, machinery and reversing beepers.
- Changes to parking and traffic conditions.
- Temporary lane/ road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas.
- Please see map for location and table for order of the works along with traffic and parking impacts.







Manhole 18 Dover Road and Yarra Street intersection	 Road closure in place on Yarra Street and Dover Road intersection. Detour signage in place to assist road users around these works. Left hand turn only onto Dover Road from Yarra Street. One way traffic (next to worksite) down Yarra Street from Douglas Parade. No entry into Yarra Street from Dover Road. Up to five car spaces will be occupied on Yarra Street to ensure a safe worksite as well as for through traffic.

Temporary traffic lights will be in place on Douglas Parade to assist road users around these works. Left hand turn only out of Holland Court onto Douglas Parade to assist parade.

Manhole 13 Douglas Parade and Peel Street intersection	 Temporary traffic lights will be in place on Douglas Parade to assist road users around these works. Peel Street (west) closed at Douglas Parade intersection No right hand turn onto Douglas Parade from Peel Street (east). Up to one car space occupied on Douglas Parade to ensure a safe worksite and through traffic. Up to three car spaces will be occupied on Peel Street to ensure a safe worksite.

Pedestrian access around the works will be maintained at all times.
