North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project

The Boulevard, Ivanhoe East

Works are progressing well on the North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation project with over 1km of sewer now relined. 13 maintenance holes have also been modified to allow access for the relining activities to take place. Rehabilitation works will ensure a safe sewerage service for local homes and businesses today, tomorrow and for generations to come.

Upcoming works in your area

To reline the sewer in your area, we will be working around the clock from mid-September to late November 2026.

Works will primarily take place in the following areas:

- Within the park reserve close to Eaglemont Tennis Club
- Within Ivanhoe Public Golf Course
- Corner of Vasey Street and The Boulevard

Road closure – Corner of Vasey Street and The Boulevard

The project team will be relining the sewer from a maintenance hole located on the corner of Vasey Street and The Boulevard. While works are underway, The Boulevard will be closed in both directions to traffic. Detours will be in place and traffic controllers will be on site to guide motorists around the works area safely.

The community will be provided with additional information including dates and duration closer to the time when The Boulevard will be closed.

What to expect

- **Hours of work:**
 - **Day works:** Site establishment works will be carried out between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday.
 - **Night works:** Relining works are required to be continuous and will be carried out 24-hours per day between 9pm Sundays and 5pm Fridays. Works may be extended to 1pm Saturdays, if required. Dates will be confirmed shortly.
- **Noise and dust:** Noise and dust will be kept to a minimum; however, works will be 24 hours with crews, machinery and lighting in place.
- **Odour:** Some odour maybe experienced while we are relining.

- **Traffic:** Detours will be in place while the relining works are carried out.
- **Eduction Truck:** We require the sewer to be in a dry condition prior to relining. In the case that ground water is coming into the sewer, we will use a vacuum/eduction truck to remove the water. Noise may be experienced during this activity.
- **Bypass pipeline and pumping:** To maintain services to homes and businesses while we are relining, several temporary sewage pumping stations will be installed. Further information on the location and duration will be provided in the coming weeks.
